Contract Title: Equipment for for invasive methods of treatment, for ultrasound and for radiological diagnostic methods in the health care facilities of the oblast.

1. The government of Ukraine has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Serving People Improving Health Project 8475-UA, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for ultrasound and for radiological diagnostic methods in the health care facilities of the oblast.

Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's rules and procedures.

2. The Health care Department of Lviv Oblast State Administration now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the supply ultrasound and for radiological diagnostic methods in the health care facilities of the oblast as per the following Lots:

Lot №1:

1. Ultrasound devices of an upper class for general examinations – 1 Pc.;
2. Ultrasound device for ultrasonic diagnostic system for general radiological and elastography examinations – 1 Pc.;
3. Ultrasound device of a premium class for a wide range of pediatric examinations – 1 Pc.;

4. Ultrasound device for ultrasonic diagnostic system for general radiological examinations – 7 Pcs.;

5. Digital mammography device of an upper class (digital mammography system) – 1 Pc.

6. Endoscopic video system in equipment set with a tool (type 1) – 1 Set;
7. Endoscopic video system in equipment set with a tool (type 2) – 1 Set;
8. Endoscopic video system in equipment set with a tool (type 3) – 1 Set.

Qualification requirements include:

If Bidder is Manufacturer: Local bidders shall submit evidence of not having deferred debts to tax authorities; bidders must have at least 5 (five) years of experience in manufacturing similar goods under each lot. The qualification of the Bidders submitting bids for several lots will be assessed on a cumulative basis; successful completion of at least 2 (two) contracts for the amount for each contract that is similar to or more than for:

Lot №1 – 168 000 (one hundred sixty-eight thousand) U.S. Dollars,

Lot №2 – 252 000 (two hundred fifty-two thousand) U.S. Dollars,

Lot №3 – 120 000 (one hundred twenty thousand) U.S. Dollars,
Lot №4 – 215 000 (two hundred fifteen thousand) U.S. Dollars,
for supply, installation, and technical support of medical equipment during the last 3 (three) years,

If a Bidder is not a manufacturer, but is offering the Goods on behalf of the Manufacturer under Manufacturer's Authorization Form (Section IV, Bidding Forms), the Manufacturer shall demonstrate the above qualifications (i), (ii), (1), and the Bidder shall demonstrate that it has successfully completed at least 2 (two) contracts for supply, installation, and technical support of similar goods during last 3 (three) years for the amount for each contract that is similar to or more than for:

Lot №1 – 168 000 (one hundred sixty-eight thousand) U.S. Dollars,

Lot №2 – 252 000 (two hundred fifty-two thousand) U.S. Dollars,

Lot №3 – 120 000 (one hundred twenty thousand) U.S. Dollars,

Lot №4 – 215 000 (two hundred fifteen thousand) U.S. Dollars.

Bidders may bid for one or several lots, as further defined in the bidding document for complete list of items within each lot only. Partial bids will not be considered and will be rejected as non-responsive. Bidders wishing to offer discounts in case they are awarded more than one contract will be allowed to do so, provided those discounts are included in the Letter of Bid.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works, and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants dated January 2011 (revised in July 2014) ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from Health care Department of Lviv Oblast State Administration and inspect the bidding documents during office hours 10:00 to 17:00 at the address given below.
